**SUBJECT:** Resolution to approve McVac Environmental Services, Inc., as a subcontractor in

connection with Contract No. <u>20-518</u> between the County of Westchester and ELQ <u>Industries, Inc.</u>, for Roadway Rehabilitation, Mamaroneck Avenue (C.R. #8, 8A, 8B, 8C & 8D), from Bryant Avenue to Mount Pleasant Avenue, a Distance of 5.09 Miles, City

of White Plains, Town of Harrison and Village of Mamaroneck, New York.

On July 1, 2021, your Honorable Board approved a resolution to award Contract No. 20-518 for Roadway Rehabilitation, Mamaroneck Avenue (C.R. #8, 8A, 8B, 8C & 8D), from Bryant Avenue to Mount Pleasant Avenue, a Distance of 5.09 Miles, City of White Plains, Town of Harrison and Village of Mamaroneck, New York, to ELQ Industries, Inc. ("ELQ"), 567 Fifth Avenue, New Rochelle, New York 10801.

Subsequent to the approval of said resolution, ELQ requested approval of a subcontractor, Fred A. Cook, Jr. Inc. ("Fred") for Cleaning Closed Drainage Systems & Drainage Structures/Video Inspection. On September 30, 2021, your Honorable Board approved Fred as a subcontractor. ELQ has now requested a change in the subcontractor. ELQ has demonstrated legitimate construction need for such a change as defined in General Municipal Law Section 101(5) since Fred is not permitted to perform this work per the PLA Agreement.

Therefore, ELQ has requested the approval of McVac Environmental Services, Inc., ("McVac") to perform Cleaning Closed Drainage Systems & Drainage Structures/Video Inspection, in connection with the above referenced contract. It should be noted that ELQ additionally canvassed 11 Enviro Group, LLC, a WBE firm, for Cleaning Closed Drainage Systems & Drainage Structures/Video Inspection; however, the firm's quoted price exceeded the budgeted amount for the type of work being requested.

The proposed subcontractor, McVac, has been investigated and the Department of Public Works and Transportation recommends approval.

Resolution to accomplish the foregoing is attached.

RESOLVED, that McVac Environmental Services, Inc., 481 Grand Avenue, New Haven, Connecticut 06513, be approved as a subcontractor for Cleaning Closed Drainage Systems & Drainage Structures/Video Inspection, on Contract No. 20-518 between the County of Westchester and ELQ Industries, Inc., 567 Fifth Avenue, New Rochelle, New York 10801, for Roadway Rehabilitation, Mamaroneck Avenue (C.R. #8, 8A, 8B, 8C & 8D), from Bryant Avenue to Mount Pleasant Avenue, a Distance of 5.09 Miles, City of White Plains, Town of Harrison and Village of Mamaroneck, New York.
