SUBJECT: Request Authority to Obtain a Proposal and Negotiate a Fee with Tectonic Engineering

Consultants, Geologists & Land Surveyors, D.P.C., in connection with Engineering Services for Signage and Wayfinding Improvements, Grasslands Campus, Valhalla, New York (#22-918)

Authority of your Honorable Board is requested to obtain a proposal and to negotiate a fee in connection with engineering services for Signage and Wayfinding Improvements, Grassiands Campus, Valhalla, New York.

The objective of this project will be to provide signage and wayfinding improvements at the Grasslands Campus. Westchester County's Grasslands Campus is a 513-acre property that is used by New York Medical College, Westchester Medical Center, and various Westchester County Departments including Emergency Services, Labs and Research, Correction, Public Safety, Probation, Environmental Facilities, Social Services, and Public Works and Transportation. Gateway monuments and signs will be installed to better direct pedestrians and vehicles throughout the Grasslands Campus. This agreement will benefit the public as it provides visitors with a more efficient way to find their destination at the Grasslands Campus.

On February 14, 2019, the Professional Prequalification Board was canvassed for the purpose of generating an eligible list of qualified firms to provide structural engineering services for under \$100,000. The Professional Prequalification Board approved a list of five (5) qualified firms. On September 18, 2020, the Board of Legislators approved Act No. 166-2020 which amends the rules and procedures that govern the prequalification and selection of architects, professional engineers, and land surveyors by increasing the maximum fee threshold from \$100,000 to \$250,000. As the fee for this procurement is estimated to be less than \$250,000, on April 20, 2022, the Professional Selection Board reviewed this eligible list of qualified firms and selected the best three qualified firms to possibly perform said services. The three firms were:

After careful consideration, the Professional Selection Board ranked the firm of Tectonic Engineering Consultants, Geologists & Land Surveyors, D.P.C., as the number one firm suitable for this proposal for these professional services. Authorization to enter into an Agreement will be submitted to your Honorable Board when negotiations are satisfactorily completed. This selection process followed the requirements as outlined in the Rules of the Professional Prequalification and Selection Boards and the Laws of Westchester County.
